

VIEW ACADEMIC PROGRAMS IN CAMPUS PARENT OR STUDENT

PATH: Campus Student/Parent (Portal) > Documents > Other > Academic Progress

Parents and students can view progress toward completing an Academic Program in the Academic Plan area of Campus Parent and Campus Student.

Steps to View Academic Programs in Campus Parent or Student

1. Navigate to **Documents**, and click on **Academic Plan Progress Report**.
2. Choose the appropriate **Graduation or Academic Program** in the drop-down menu. The report will default to the **Graduation Program** assigned to the student by the school.
3. Check either a **Summary** or a **Detail** view of the **Report Type**.
4. Select **PDF** or **DOCX** for the output **Report Format**.
5. Click **Generate Report**.
